Programme Content

The MSc programme which includes completion of a dissertation will take one calendar year to complete.

Students can choose to exit with a Postgraduate Certificate after successfully completing a 60 credit module in Professional Practice or a Postgraduate Diploma after successfully completing 120 credits (Professional Practice, Advanced Classical Texts and Research Methods). Both the PGCert and the PGDip can be completed over 2 semesters (an academic year).

Currently the fees for this course are UK/EU £4,600 and for international students £9,400.
