Dear Mr Batty

Your request for information received on 9 January 2018 has been dealt with under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

You asked:

1. Has the university received any funding, including but not limited to donations, gifts, legacies and sponsorship, from Saudi individuals and/or organisations, including but not limited to companies, foundations, charities, non-profit organisations, state institutions, NGOs, royalty, over the past six years?
2. What was the total value of this funding?
3. Which department was the main beneficiary of this funding?
4. What was the value of the largest donation received?
5. Over the past six years, have any staff at the university provided education services, including but not limited to teaching, marking, supervisions, lecturing, tutoring, pastoral care, advisory and consultancy work, at Saudi educational institutions?

*N.B. The six years I'm requesting data for are the following **university financial years**:

2012-13
2013-14
2014-15
2015-16
2016-17
2017-18 (to 8 Jan 2018)

University Response

The University has not received any funding, including but not limited to donations, gifts, legacies and sponsorship, from Saudi individuals and/or organisations, including but not limited to companies, foundations, charities, non-profit organisations, state institutions, NGOs, royalty, over the past six years.

We are unable to provide a response to question 5. As you did not provide a response to our request for clarification issued on 9 January 2018.

I trust this satisfies your request sufficiently. Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, you have the right to complain about the University's response to your request for information.
