You asked:

I have a question about the financial performance of any residences at your institution in financial year 2016/17.

For clarity I would like to know:

- About the financial performance (both income and expenditure) you declare in your main accounts within “residences, catering and conferences” **but with any income or expenditure attributable to catering or conferences removed**
- We would like direct costs and indirect costs such as depreciation and any loan repayments separately listed
- The number of bedspaces that these figures cover
