Your request for information received on 2 May 2018 has been dealt with under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

You asked:

I am writing to ask who your incumbent mobile supplier is and how long the current contract has left until it is completed. Thank you and I hope to hear from you soon.

### **University Response**

The University's supplier is EE  
Initial call off period is 3 years (23 March 2017 – 22 March 2020).  
Based on this initial call off period, there would be just over 21 months remaining

There is however the option of an extension for a maximum of 2 further years.  
This is under Crown Commercial Service's National Further Competition (NFC63 Mobile Voice & Data Services), National Services Agreement RM1045, Lot6

I trust this satisfies your request sufficiently. Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, you have the right to complain about the University's response to your request for information.
