Alumni Scholarship

Academic Merit Scholarship

The Academic Merit Scholarship requires applicants to have passed their undergraduate degree with an upper second or first class honours degree, and to fulfill all the stated entry requirements for the postgraduate programme of their choice.

2. Unless otherwise stated, the scholarships apply to programmes commencing in September 2018, at the Malta Campus and cannot be used for study at other campuses.
3. Unless otherwise stated, all scholarships are to be offered once for one postgraduate programme.
4. Academic Merit Scholarship recipients will be announced during the week commencing **3rd September 2018**.
5. Scholarships are designated for a specific year of study and cannot be deferred from one academic year to the next.
6. Scholarships cannot be exchanged for cash funds or transferred.
7. The University reserves the right to withdraw or amend the scholarship from time to time.
8. The University reserves the right to cancel the award of scholarship if a student is found in breach of any guidelines set by the University or has falsified any information.
9. The decisions made by the University are final and there are no provisions or processes for appeal.
10. Students must apply for the Merit Scholarship using this application form and must attach all required supporting documents mentioned above. The deadline for the Merit Scholarship is **31st August 2018**
