

WHAT HAPPENS TO OUR WASTE?

GENERAL WASTE

General Waste is collected by Biffa and sent to Edmonton Station.
All general waste is used to generate electricity, this means 0% directly sent to landfill.

Carrier Bags, Food Wrappers, Crisp Packets, Disposable Coffee Cups, Hand Towels etc.



MIXED RECYCLING

Mixed Recycling is collected By Biffa and sent to Edmonton for MRF (Materials Recovery Facility) processing and recycling.

Paper, Cardboard, Plastic Bottles, Cans, Sandwich Boxes, etc.



FOOD WASTE

**Food Waste is collected by Biffa and sent for Anaerobic Digestion –
this generates biogas, electricity, and fertiliser.**


Food Leftovers, Coffee Grounds, Tea Bags, Peelings, and any other food items



BATTERIES

The Batteries are collected by WasteCare and recycled –
use the bins across campus.


Batteries only



CONFIDENTIAL WASTE

Confidential waste is collected by Restore via a BS7858 vetted Secure Collection Operative and sent to Crayford Secure Destruction facility, shredded to the BSEN15713:2009 standard and then recycled – use the dedicated confidential waste bins across campus.

Separated wood is collected by Biffa
Wood and timber only
