

Showreel Guidance

A showreel is a recording or a video that introduces you and demonstrates your technical and creative ability in one or more of the following areas – performance; composition/songwriting and music production.

Please provide an unlisted link to a video of yourself performing or improvising on your first-study instrument or voice on a video sharing website such as Youtube.

This should be submitted in as a link in an MS Word document. If you are not primarily a performer, you may share and talk at the interview about composition or harmony exercise you have notated; a recording or a song you've written or a track you've produced.

If you have booked for an online interview, please provide this prior to attending.

If you are not undertaking an interview, please provide one or more of the following for the tutor to review:

A video of yourself performing on your first-study instrument or voice;

- A recording of a song or piece you've written;
- A digital file (e.g. Logic, ProTools) for a track you've produced;
- The score of a notated composition or harmony exercise.
