

## **Showreel Guidance**

A showreel is a recording or a video that introduces you and demonstrates your technical and creative ability in one or more of the following areas – performance, composition/songwriting or music production.

Please provide an unlisted link to a video of yourself performing or improvising on your first-study instrument or voice on a video sharing website such as YouTube.

This should be submitted as a link in a Word document. If you are not primarily a performer, you may share and talk at the interview about a composition or harmony exercise you have notated; a recording or a song you've written; or a track you've produced.

**If you have booked an online interview**, please provide this prior to attending.

**If you are not undertaking an interview**, please provide one or more of the following for the tutor to review:

## A video of yourself performing on your first-study instrument or voice;

- A recording of a song or piece you've written;
- A digital file (e.g. Logic, ProTools) for a track you've produced;
- The score of a notated composition or harmony exercise.
