WELCOME

IVY HALL is located at 100 Cricklewood Lane, Cricklewood, London NW2 2DQ, close to the Cricklewood Train Station. To access it, please refer to a satellite navigation system.

On arrival, please report to the Accommodation Office in Block 1, which is to the left of the pedestrian gate. If you are driving, you will be able to park for a few minutes in the car park to move your belongings to the reception area or courtyard. The office staff will be there on hand to welcome you, issue your keys and show you to your room. Their usual office hours are 9 AM to 5 PM, but if you arrive outside of these hours or have any queries regarding your travel, please call them on 07788 635866 or email at ivyhall@mdx.ac.uk.

WAYS TO TRAVEL

By Public Transport The nearest train station to Ivy Hall is Cricklewood, which is operated by Thameslink. From Cricklewood Station, turn left and Ivy Hall is on the right, approximately a two-minute walk down Cricklewood Lane.

From Heathrow Airport Take an underground train on the Elizabeth line toward Abbey Wood from the platform at Heathrow Terminals 2 & 3. Once you reach Farringdon, change for an overground Thameslink train to St Albans City and remain on board until you arrive at Cricklewood Train Station. The journey will approximately take an hour and thirty minutes and cost £9.90 during the peak and £6.70 during the off-peak hours.

From Gatwick Airport Board a Thameslink overground train to Cambridge. Alight from it at Farringdon, where you should change for a train to St Albans City. Alight from the train when you arrive at Cricklewood Train Station. The journey will approximately take an hour and fifteen minutes and cost £18.40 during the peak and £10.10 during the off-peak hours.

From Stansted Airport Board an A5 National Express coach to Paddington. Change at Golders Green for a 460 bus to Willesden Bus Garage and alight from it at Claremont Road Cricklewood (Stop CN), which is right outside the entrance to Ivy Hall. The journey will approximately take an hour and thirty minutes and cost £17.75, if you prebook your coach ticket online.

Taxis Various service providers or black cabs are available for pre-booking online or ad-hoc at most major airports, and train or tube stations. Always ask for a quote before your journey. All drivers are required to carry an ID.
