

WELCOME

USHER HALL is located at The Burroughs, Hendon, London, NW4 4HE, opposite the Hendon Campus. To access it, please refer to a satellite navigation system.

On arrival, please report to the Accommodation Office in Block A. If you are driving, you will be able to park for a few minutes to move your belongings to the reception area. The office staff will be there on hand to welcome you, issue your keys and show you to your room. Their usual office hours are 9 AM to 5 PM, but if you arrive outside of these hours or have any queries regarding your travel, please call them on 020 8036 0006 or email at usher.hall@southernhousing.org.uk.

WAYS TO TRAVEL

By Public Transport The nearest underground station is Hendon Central (Northern Line) When you exit the station, turn right, and take a right at the top of the hill onto The Burroughs. Turn right into Babington Road and Usher Hall is situated on the left-hand side.

From Heathrow Airport Take an underground train on the Elizabeth line to Abbey Wood from a platform at Heathrow Terminals 2 & 3. Once you arrive at Tottenham Court Road Station, change for a Northbound train on the Northern Line to Edgware and alight from the train at Hendon Central. The journey will take approximately an hour and thirty minutes and cost £5.60 - £6.70.

From Gatwick Airport Take a Thameslink overground train to Bedford or Cambridge and change at London Bridge Station for a Northbound underground train on the Northern Line to Edgware. Alight from the train once you arrive at Hendon Central. The journey will take approximately an hour and thirty minutes and cost £21.20 during the peak and £12.80 during the off-peak hours.

From Stansted Airport Board an A5 National Express coach to Paddington. At Golders Green, change for a 183 bus to Pinner, departing from Finchley Road (Stop GN), and continue until you reach Hendon Town Hall (Stop P). The hall is only a three-minute walk away. The journey will take approximately an hour and thirty minutes and cost £17.75.

Taxis Various service providers and black cabs are posted or available for pre-booking online at most major airports, train and tube stations. We recommend that you ask for a quote before you begin your journey. All drivers are required to carry an ID at all times.
