

WELCOME

WOOD GREEN HALL is located at Brabant Road, N22 6UZ, London. To access it, please refer to a satellite navigation system.

On arrival, please report to the Accommodation Office located on the left-hand side. If you are driving, you will be able to park for a few minutes to move your belongings to the reception area. The office staff will be there on hand to welcome you, issue your keys and show you to your room. Their usual office hours are 9 AM to 5 PM, but if you arrive outside of these hours or have any queries regarding your travel, please call them on 0208 036 0061 or email at woodgreenhall@southernhousing.org.uk.

WAYS TO TRAVEL

By Public Transport The nearest underground station is Wood Green (Picadilly Line). When you exit the station, cross the street and walk on straight ahead up Station Road until you reach a turn on your left onto Brabant Road. Wood Green Hall is the second building situated on the right-hand side.

From Heathrow Airport Take the underground Piccadilly train to Cockfosters from a platform at Heathrow Terminal 4. Stay on board until you reach Wood Green. The journey will take approximately an hour and thirty minutes and cost £5.60 - £6.70.

From Gatwick Airport Take a Thameslink overground train to Bedford or Cambridge and change at Finsbury Park Station for an underground train on the Piccadilly Line to Arnos Grove. Alight from the train once you arrive at Wood Green. The journey will take approximately an hour and cost £21.20 during the peak and £12.80 during the off-peak hours.

From Stansted Airport Board a Stansted Express train to London Liverpool Street, departing from platform 1. At Tottenham Hale, change for a 123 bus to Wood Green, departing from Tottenham Hale Bus Station, and continue until you reach Wood Green Station (Stop HB). The hall is only a four-minute walk away. The journey will take approximately an hour and thirty minutes and cost £22.45.

Taxis Various service providers and black cabs are posted or available for pre-booking online at most major airports, train and tube stations. We recommend that you ask for a quote before you begin your journey. All drivers are required to carry an ID at all times.
