Below are some questions the admissions tutor will ask during your veterinary nursing online interview, to help with your preparation. You may also wish to note down any questions you may have for us, and anything else you would like to tell us on the day. Your interview should last for around 20-30 minutes.

1. Why have you chosen to apply to Middlesex University to study veterinary nursing?
2. Have you visited the campus you have applied for yet?
3. Describe your experience of working with animals (e.g. equine/large animal/companion animal/exotics/zoos)
4. Tell us about any pets you have now or have had in the past.
5. Describe any work experience that you have undertaken in a veterinary practice (e.g. where/when/duration/references/tasks undertaken/the best and worst experiences)
6. What academic subjects have you found the most interesting and the most difficult?
7. Have you thought about what role(s) you would like to apply for after you graduate?
8. Can you identify any of the key components of the role of a qualified veterinary nurse working in veterinary practice?
9. What do you think are some of the main challenges facing the veterinary profession at the moment? Why are they important to veterinary nursing?
10. From your own experience – what do you think are the benefits and challenges of working as part of a team?
11. What personal qualities do you possess that will enable you to be an effective veterinary nurse?
12. What do you think you will find difficult or challenging during your veterinary nurse training?
